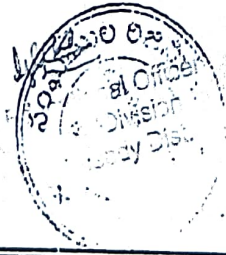

RULES & REGULATIONS

OF

SANDIAH EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY

1. NAME:

The society shall be known as "SANDIAH EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY".

2. LOCATION:

It shall be located in Hyderabad (A.P) and its registered offices for the present be situate at door no. 1-59/15, Maseedbanda, Kondapur, Hyderabad-500 084.R R Dist

3. MEMBERSHIP:

The membership of the society shall consist of persons mainly interested in development of education and also to fulfill the other objects of the society. All the members will pay the annual membership fees of the society of Rs. 100/- (Rupees one hundred only) and there shall be no admission fee.

4. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP:

Membership of the organization shall ipso facto terminate, if

- a. A member tenders his resignation to the society, or
- b. The executive committee decides by a majority vote to terminate membership of any member after such member has been given an opportunity of being heard in this matter.

5. LIABILITY OF MEMBERS:

The liability of the members is limited.

6. EXECUTIVE BODY:

The affairs of the society shall be administered by an executive committee consisting of five members the executive members shall elect from its members a president and a secretary.

8. POWER OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

The executive body shall have to do all such things required to carry out the objects of the organization and which are, by the act not required to be exercised or done by, the organization in the general body meeting. The executive committee shall also have the power from time to time, by a simple majority of votes to make, vary and repeal rules and regulations for the transaction of the business administration of the organization and of itself.

Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing powers the executive committee shall have the following power for carrying out the objects of the organization.

- For any of the objects and purposes of the organization to employ and procure the assistance of any personal or staff, either for remuneration or gratuitously and on such terms as the executive committee may deem fit, or to discharge, or dismiss the same.
- To collect, raise, receive, borrow, funds, money and property with or without conditions and to spend, use, invest or utilize and to turn into account the same. The executive body for this purpose can mortgage any of the properties of the society, which are not detrimental to and the objects of the society.
- To open, operate and close banking accounts and accounts of the organization and to decide and authorize person or persons to operate such banking accounts, whether same be overdrawn or not.
- To negotiate and to enter into any agreements with any government, central or state, municipality, board or any other public or private authority, body or association which may seem beneficial or conducive to any of the objects of the organization.
- To enter into and carry out arrangements for joint working or for amalgamation with any other association, society or institution having objects in keeping with the objects of the organization.
- To appoint such person or persons as the executive committee may deem fit for the purpose of representing the organization and or the

- g) Generally to do all such things as may be deemed by the executive committee to be incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the above objects.

9. OFFICE BEARERS:

The office bearers of the society shall consist of *president and secretary*. The term of office of the executive committee and office bearers shall be three years and after the expiry of the term, the general body shall elect the executive committee and office bearers.

10. ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING:

The annual general body meeting of the society shall be held in the month of may or as near thereto as possible and accounts shall be presented at the meeting prepared on the 31st march, of each year. The president shall preside at all meetings of the society or in the event of his absence any member of the society may be elected as chairmen for conducting that particular meeting. The annual general body meeting shall be within six months of closing of the financial year; at the annual general body meeting the following business shall be transacted.

- a) To approve the accounts of the society together with the auditors and executive committee report.
- b) To appoint auditors.
- c) To receive the annual report.
- d) To approve the report of activities of the society and the expenditure statement of the previous financial year.
- e) To select executive committee.

11. CO-OPTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNING BODY:

The executive committee shall have power to co-opt for a period of one year and not more than four persons who shall be the members of the society in the executive committee. The members co-opted for the purpose of executive committee shall hold office till the conclusion of the next annual general body meeting or for a period of one year whichever is less.

12. FUNDS:

The funds shall be spent only to the attainment of the objects of the society and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly to any of its members by any means

13. TERMS OF OFFICE:

- a) The terms of office of the president, and secretary and members of the executive committee shall normally be for three years.
- b) With the exception of the secretary one third of the members of the executive committee shall be liable to retire by rotation at every annual general meeting of the society, or if their number is no three or a multiple of three, then the number nearest to one third, shall retire from office.
- c) At the annual general body meeting at which the members of the governing body retire by reelecting members or any other member in his place.
- d) The member to retire by rotation at the annual general meeting shall be those who have been longest in office since their last election, but as between members who were appointed to the executive committee on the same day, those who are to retire shall be determined by lot.
- e) The retiring members are eligible for re-election.

14. EXTRA ORDINARY GENERAL MEETING:

The meeting of the members may be convened by

1. The president and the secretary of the centre for carrying out any specific business and such notice shall contain full particulars of the business to be transacted at such extra ordinary meeting
2. On requisition of not less than 1/3 of the members and such members requisitioning extra ordinary general meeting shall specify the purpose and full particulars be given. On receipts of such requisition the president and the secretary shall take necessary action for conducting extra ordinary meeting for the purpose specified by such members.

15. MAINTENANCE OF BOOKS OF ACCOUNT:

- a) The proper books of account showing receipts and disbursements and made an accounts of the trust hereby constituted shall be kept by the trustees.
- b) The board of trustees shall from time to time determine whether and to what extent and at what times and places and under what conditions or regulations, the accounts and books of the society, or any of them, shall be open to the inspection of members not being trustees.
- c) No members (not being a trustee) shall have any right of inspecting any accounts or books or documents of the society except as conferred by law or authorized by the board or by the society in general meeting.
- d) The trustees shall lay before each annual general meeting income and expenditure account for the financial year of the society and balance sheet made upto the end of financial year and such books.

of account shall be got audited with all necessary vouchers once at least in very year by such chartered accountant or chartered accountants as trustee may appoint from time to time and trustees may fix and pay the remuneration of such chartered accountant or chartered accountants.

16. INVESTMENT OF TRUST FUNDS:

The trust shall invest the trust funds in one or more of the investments specified in accordance with sec.11 (5) of the Income tax act.

FUNDS AND ASSETS:

1. Subscriptions, donations, grants of all kinds given by members or non-members and properties purchased or otherwise get, shall constitute the assets of and shall vest in the association.
2. If any donor or grantor directs that his donation or grant shall be utilized. But whenever such utilization becomes impracticable the governing body may utilize the same for other purposes of the association.
3. Subject to the foregoing rules the funds of the association shall be utilized for the attainment of the objects of the association and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly to any of its members through any members.

The funds of the association, shall from time to time, be deposited in any bank authorized by the governing body.

SUITS AND PROPERTIES:

On behalf of the association, the president shall sue or to sued, he shall be vested with the powers of acquiring land and transferring property movable or immovable or entering into contracts and doing all things necessary, proper or expedient to carry out the objects of the associations.

17. MISCELLANEOUS:

1. The general body has interest power to call in question any acts done by the governing body detrimental to the interests of the association and can alter or modify such act or acts or to pass no-confidence motion against any office bearer or office bearers, if it is so resolved by not less than 2/3rds of its members or rolls.
2. The general body and sub-committee shall at the time of its meeting ascertain the vote of majority either by show of hands or ballot or otherwise as he for the time being directs.
3. The president of any committee shall at the time of its meeting ascertain the vote of majority either by show of hands or ballot or otherwise as he for the time being directs.
